WHAT TO EXPECT

Season & Weekly Play

- Occurs weekly each Thursday night across scheduled league dates between April 3 through September 11, 2025.
- Weekly league play includes a 9-hole shotgun format (all groups tee off at the same time from different holes) starting at 5:00pm 5:30pm (light depending).
- Players are expected to arrive 15-20 mins early to ensure ample time for sign-in/payment and to get organized for their starting location.

Keeping Score

- One score card per team/group is turned into the pro shop at the end of play.
- Scores will be posted to golf genius where players can see their standing.

Games & Prizes

- Weekly "Chip-In" Pot
 - Players choosing to play pay \$1 each week (upon check-in) to participate. Any player that makes a hole from "off the green" wins the pot. If there are no winners, money carries over to the following week.
- Weekly Games
 - Weekly contests (various golf games, and longest drive, longest putt, etc) with winners earning credit to spend in the Echo Fall Golf Pro Shop.
 - o NOTE: An active GHIN rating must be in place to compete in any game.

Food & Beverages

- Available from Strikers Bar and Grill (open until 9pm April September).
- Food and drinks are available in person or by calling ahead (360-822-2118) anytime.
- 20% food discount, with \$1.50 off wine and .75 cents off Rainier/Coors Light on league nights.

League Play

- All golf will be played according to **USGA Rules**.
- The expected pace of play is approx. 15 mins per hole.
 - o If you are more than double the par and not on the green, you may pick up and place your ball on fringe of green to finish.
- The maximum group size is 4 people (no exceptions).
- Cart rules (as posted) must be followed by players at all times.
 - o At no time may golf carts be driven near the greens or on any tee boxes.
- A GHIN will be established (if not already in place) for all active Ladies Club members.
 - For new accounts, please note three 18-hole rounds are required to establish your rating.

Birdie/Eagle Tree

- Birdies (1 under par) and eagles (2 under par) on any hole will be recognized by inclusion on the "Birdie/Eagle Tree".
 - Players achieving a birdie/eagle should circle it on the scorecard and alert pro shop staff when turning it in.
 - Pro shop staff will provide you with a birdie/eagle badge for you to write your name/hole # for addition to the recognition tree.

Sportsmanship

- Players must count every stroke taken (no "gimmies") and finish all putts into the hole.
- Players are expected to treat others (players/staff) with kindness, dignity, and respect at all times.
- Players should contribute to course care. Replace divots, smooth bunkers, and repair ball marks as you encounter them throughout game play.
- Players must dispose of all trash in the proper receptacles.
- Failure to adhere to EFGC or Ladies Club rules may result in removal from the league.

Guests

- Players may bring one (1) guest per Ladies Club night, noting a limit of 6 guests each season.
 - o Guests are limited to 2 visits each per season, after which they are welcome to join the club.
 - o Guests must be registered/paid at the pro-shop prior to game play.
